Why was the tomb empty? Here are some claims people make. Can you find what the mistake with each claim makes?

The Roman soldiers or the Jewish leaders must have taken Jesus' body.

The tomb was sealed and a roman guard was stationed outside it to prevent this from happening. Matt 27:62-66

Jesus' disciples stole the body to make it appear that he'd come back to life.

They went to the tomb and watched him being laid inside. Also they'd have probably spotted a Roman guard outside a different tomb and realised their mistake. Luke 23:55

Jesus is alive.

Jesus wasn't dead, he'd just fainted so later he recovered and walked out the tomb.

Graves were sometimes broken into but who takes the body but waits to refold the more valuable grave clothes? Also there was a ROMAN GUARD!

The woman went to the wrong tomb – there was never anyone in it.

They didn't want people to think Jesus was alive. If they had his dead body why didn't they show everyone. Acts 5:27-28

A graverobber stole Jesus' body and didn't know whose it was.

Roman soldiers were trained killers: they could tell if a person was dead. They stabbed him in the side to make sure. John 19:34
